Charles Michael Murray is a nationally recognized multidisciplinary creative director whose work spans fine art, commercial photography, documentary film, brand strategy, and environmental advocacy. With four decades of experience, Murray has built a career at the intersection of art, commerce, and cultural stewardship bringing visionary storytelling to both global brands and grassroots initiatives.

As founder of CMM Studio, Murray engaged with award-caliber creative campaigns for clients including Salomon, Disneyland, Honeywell, Epson, JVC, Head Sports, Helly Hansen, Carl's Jr., Rubio's, and Beck's; among many others across technology, retail, medical, real estate, food and beverage, and nonprofit sectors. His integrated expertise across print, digital, video, and internet strategy positioned him early as a pioneer in cross-platform brand storytelling.

Beyond commercial success, Murray is widely respected for his environmental leadership. He founded the **Endangered Planet Foundation**, a nonprofit dedicated to raising awareness of environmental causes through art, education, and community engagement; conceived and co-produced the three-day **One Earth | One Dream** Eco-Festival at the Festival of Arts in Laguna Beach, California, uniting artists, environmental organizations, and the public in a landmark celebration of regeneration, sustainability, and creative activism.

Murray's advisory work continues to encourage organizations to reduce marketing footprints and adopt environmentally responsible production practices across various mediums, reinforcing his long-standing commitment to ecological stewardship.

On November 11, 1989, Murray conceived and helped lead **The Walk to Save Laguna Canyon** — a massive environmental demonstration in Laguna Beach, California, that drew thousands of participants to protest proposed development and became a defining moment in regional conservation history.

Murray's fine art career, highlighted by his multi-decade **Legend Series**, has been exhibited at distinguished venues including Caesars Palace, Las Vegas, Nevada; Pro Football Hall of Fame, Canton, Ohio; Four Seasons Hotel, Newport Beach, California; Universal Studios, Hollywood, California and Aloha Tower, Honolulu, Hawaii.

Through **My Legacy Tree**, Murray's production firm, he has directed and produced documentaries focused on heritage, art, and environmental themes, including projects connected to the **Art Miles Mural Project**, Oceanside, California. His films preserve community narratives and celebrate creative pioneers while addressing contemporary, cultural and environmental challenges.

Murray holds a MS and BA degree from Brooks Institute, Santa Barbara, California. He taught photography while collaborating with leaders in the advertising industry, mentoring the next generation of photographers and visual communicators.

Today, **Charles Michael Murray** continues to produce impactful work across design, photography, film, and digital media; bringing strategic clarity, artistic excellence, and environmental consciousness to his endeavors. Murray's career reflects a sustained commitment to shaping culture through powerful visual communication while championing environmental responsible visionary leadership in communications that shape culture on a national scale. Endangered Planet Foundation (EPF) was established in 2007 by graphic designer and photographer Charles Michael Murray as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit in Laguna Beach, California. Murray created the foundation as the philanthropic arm of his environmentally focused art space, the Endangered Planet Gallery.

The foundation's core purpose is to raise awareness of environmental and pro-sustainability issues by connecting the arts, education, and public dialogue with conservation goals. Its activities include exhibitions, seminars, environmental education programs, festivals, and creative community events that highlight ecological concerns and inspire action toward a sustainable future. Murray emphasized the role of technological innovation and community engagement in finding solutions to environmental challenges.

The Foundation's mission is to ensure the survival of the Earth by fostering awareness, collaboration, and solutions-oriented engagement. Through exhibitions, educational programs, film screenings, panel discussions, and cross-sector partnerships, it bridges art, science, and technology demonstrating that cultural influence and innovation together can drive measurable progress toward a regenerative and sustainable future.

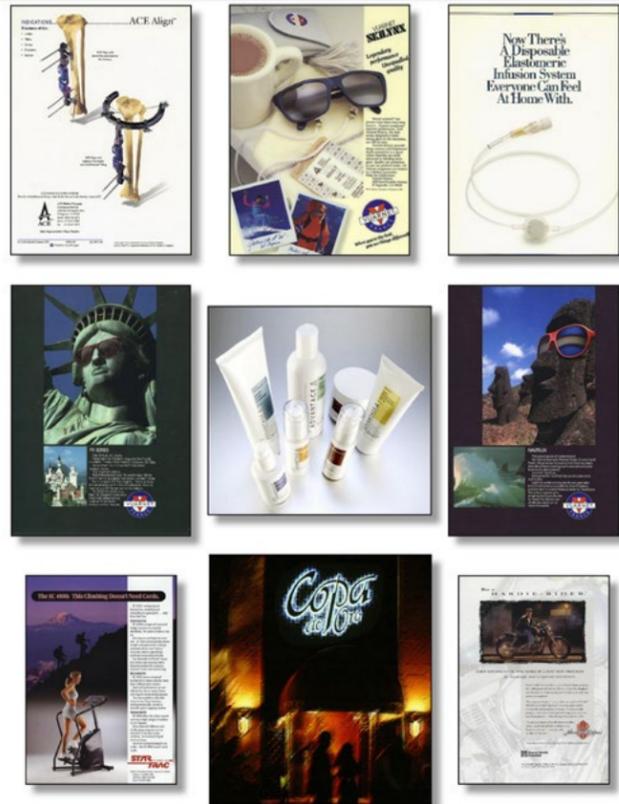
One Earth | One Dream

The organization recognizes that advances in technology, combined with cultural engagement and education provide viable pathways toward a regeneratively sustainable future. **One Earth | One Dream** work fosters awareness, encourages stewardship, and empowers communities to participate in solutions.



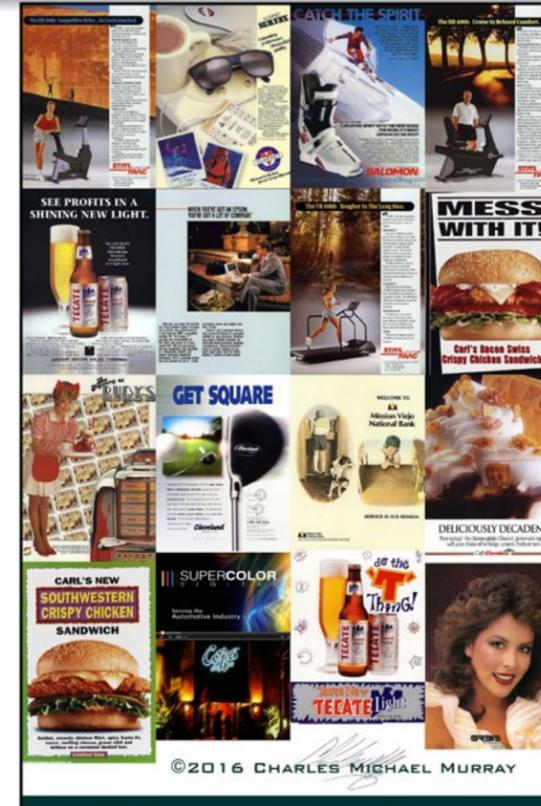

Ten Challenges to its Legacy and Character

This is the story of how the small community of Laguna Beach, known as an artist colony with its some 25,000 residents living along the Pacific Ocean and surrounded by a Gemball of 22,000 acres of preserved open space amidst sandy beaches, dramatic canyons, mountains, coves and arches evolved as a community conscious of its uniqueness, village character, and leadership in environmental protection. Originally borne to Native Americans, later surrounded by large ranches and Spanish and Mexican land grants, the present town evolved from 1875 to 1916 and its ensuing development related not only to its beautiful natural setting, but also to sensitivity to urban design. Its natural setting inspired plein or open-air artists.

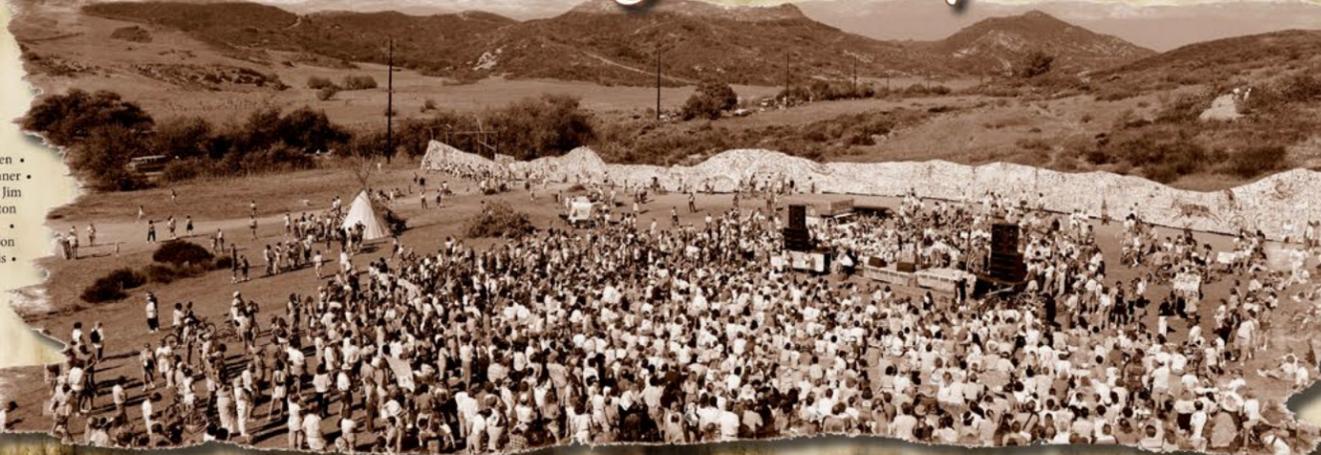

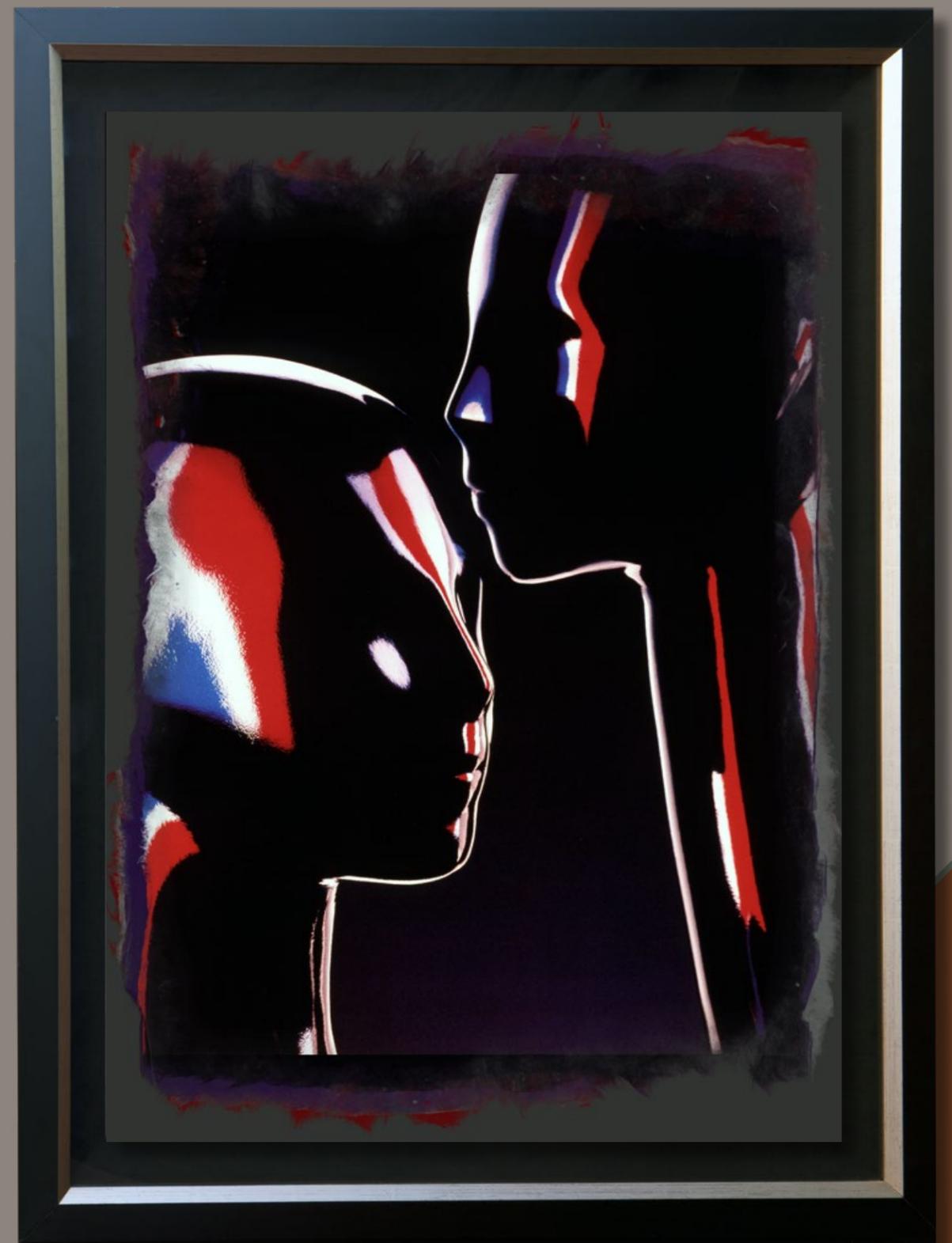

Charles Michael Murray envisioned and brought to life the original concept for this landmark event. He photographed the sweeping panoramic and four key images, then designed the striking banner that stretches across Forest Ave., Laguna Beach, CA. This banner continues to inspire, appearing at local events and annually at the NIX Nature Center, celebrating the anniversary of “Together – We Saved Laguna Canyon – Nov. 11, 1989.” Charles, alongside many others dedicated to its success were instrumental in preserving Laguna Canyon, turning a fight against over-development into a lasting legacy of community action and environmental stewardship.



Charles Michael Murray conceived a powerful visual concept that blends artistry with activism, featuring imagery of a peace dove, a patriotic kiss of red, white, and blue, and Tembo, The Majestic One, an evolutionary piece celebrating the African elephant and endangered species preservation. Murray's art supports and complements his organizations EPF and its eco-festival venture One Earth | One Dream, bringing together conservation, culture, and community. Through these works, Charles highlights the need to protect nature while celebrating the resilience and spirit of communities committed to environmental stewardship.

With his visionary approach, Charles connects the arts with regeneration and preservation, transforming visual storytelling into a call to action. His imagery invites audiences to reflect on the delicate balance between human creativity and the natural world, inspiring engagement, awareness, and meaningful participation in protecting our shared planet.
